"I had learnt the true practice of law. I had learnt to find out the better side of human nature and to enter men's hearts. These individual victories also pave the way for a peaceful and harmonious society and illustrate the

underlying principle of conflict resolution that the good of the individual is contained in the good of all.




"Generations to come will scarce believe that such a one as this ever, in flesh and blood, walked upon this earth."


